



Adult Early Music Beauchamp House Course 2-8 August 2020 Accommodation FAQs

Where will the course be held?

Rendcomb College which lies between Cheltenham and Cirencester. Set in 230 acres of stunning Cotswold countryside, Rendcomb's beautiful landscape is bordered by the river Churn.

Where will the music activities take place?

In the wood-panelled Reading Room (frequently used as a chamber concert venue), the large Orangery, the spacious dining hall, and the large entrance hall. There are plenty of additional break-out spaces for smaller ensemble work. GAM will have exclusive use of the building.

What are the catering arrangements?

The college catering team will be providing meals. This will consist of a cooked breakfast; 'cold counter' lunch with soups, fruit and yogurt and a two-course evening meal (fish/meat and veggie options) plus puddings or fruit. The course can make its own wine/bar arrangements, as in previous years.

What form does the accommodation take?

Individual student rooms are in plentiful supply. The course will have sole use of Park House, a large accommodation block adjacent to the main house. There are shared bathrooms with wash basins, showers and toilets on each floor. There are comfortable common rooms for relaxing and socialising during the breaks. Full bedding will be supplied by Rendcomb College, guests to bring their own towels. A small number of double rooms are available in a separate house.



Will there be an option to camp?

Yes. There will be a space set aside in the grounds for those who wish to camp.

What other amenities are there nearby?

The Bathurst Arms pub is 1.6 miles away. Cirencester is 6 miles away and Cheltenham 11 miles from Rendcomb. There is a bus service along the A435 to both towns.
